# 1. Mask Making - 13th March, 2020.



### 52<sup>nd</sup> Foundation Day

### Thurday,16th July 2020, 5:00 pm

Modern Education Society's' Ness Wadia college of Commerce celebrated its 52<sup>nd</sup> Foundation Day on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2020. The Scholar of the Year award was conferred upon Hon'ble Dr Naushad Forbes (Co-Chairman, Forbes Marshall Pvt. Ltd.) for his distinguished contribution to the field of Energy Management and Education. The Chief Guest for the Function was Hon'ble Prof Dr Nitin Kalmalkar, (Vice Chancellor, SPPU). The entire ceremony was conducted virtually via Zoom and was projected on Facebook Live keeping in mind the lockdown situation due to Covid-19 pandemic.

The prestigious award ceremony was graced with the presence of Mr Ganeshan, (CFO Modern Education Society) Dr Sampada Joshi, Dr Chandak, Dr Abhay Hake and Dr Manohar Sanap (Trustees of Modern Education Society).
