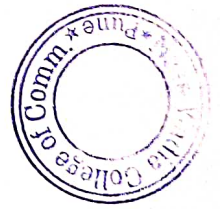

To widen the horizons of our students, the college is closely associated with successful and renowned people from the business world to share their experiences with our students and prepare them for the realworld.

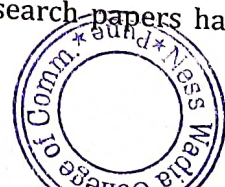
Scholar of the Year Award:

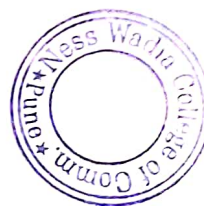

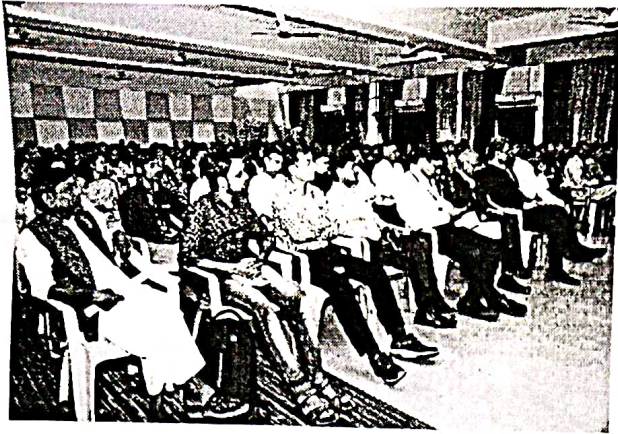

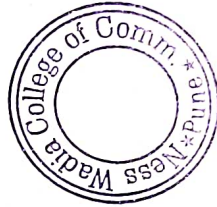

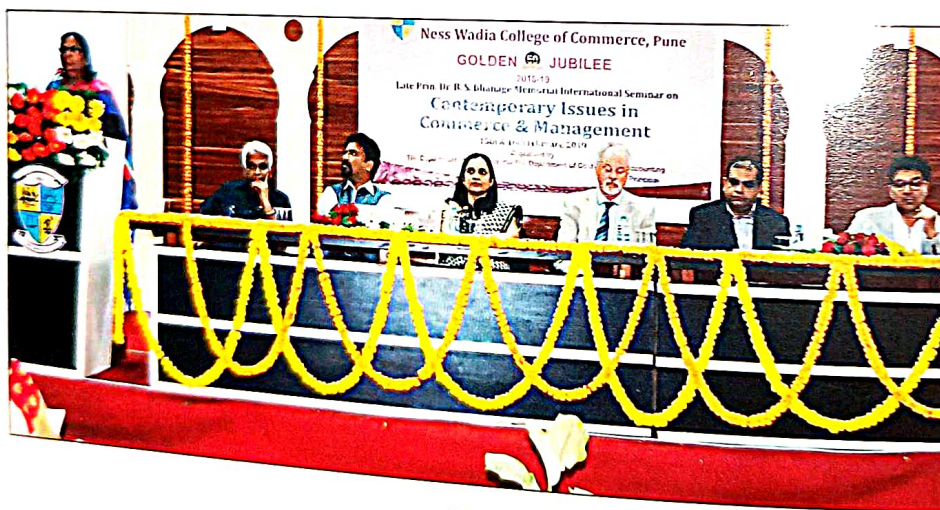

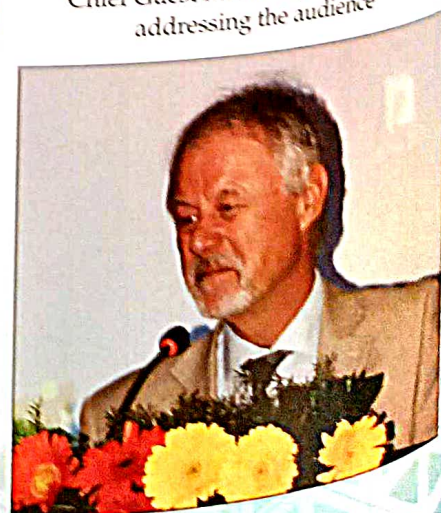
